

American vs. Russian Account of Truman and the Bomb






American vs. Chinese Account of 1999 Bombing of Embassy in Belgrade










Surface Level: "Specific Narratives"

• Surface form:

Includes concrete information about times, places, and actors

– Example:

World War II started in 1939 with Germany's attack on Poland. In 1941
Germany invaded the Soviet Union, and later that year Japan attacked the
U.S. at Pearl Harbor. The war proceeded with battles near Moscow and at
Stalingrad and the Kursk salient, followed by the Allied invasion of Europe on
D-Day, and it concluded with the collapse and surrender of Germany in May
1945 and the atomic bombing of Japan followed by its surrender in August
1945.

Russian Narrative Template: "Expulsion-of-Alien-Enemies"

- 1. Russia is peaceful and not interfering with others
- 2. A foreign enemy attacks Russia without provocation
- 3. Russia nearly loses everything in total defeat as it suffers from the enemy's attempts to destroy it as a civilization
- 4. Through heroism and exceptionalism, and acting alone, Russia triumphs and succeeds in expelling the alien enemy

National Mental Realities

- 1. Can manage, but not transcend conflicting mental realities
- 2. Need to address narrative templates/fast thinking
- 3. Need for humility
 - "Modern man lacks the humility to accept the fact that the whole drama of history is enacted in a frame of meaning too large for human comprehension." (Niebuhr: The Irony of American History)
- 4. Education
 - Comfortable space for uncomfortable ideas: trust
